ENTRY GUIDELINES

- *1. Entry Form for all departments must be submitted by mail.
Closing date for registration is August 2, 2007. Deadline for us to receive mailed in entries is August 2, 2007.
Please send in your entry form as early as possible.
 2. We will confirm all registrations by mail.
 - *3. Entries and registration confirmation must then be brought to the Creative Arts Building on August 17, 18, or 19, 2007. Hours are 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Only registered participants will be admitted. There is no process for late registration. We must receive your entry form by August 2, 2007 if you wish to participate in 2007.
 4. We accept entries by mail. Please see the General Rules, numbers 8 and 9 for information.
 5. Use the entry form included in the back of this booklet to register in all departments.
 6. Payment of entry fees in full must accompany all registrations.
Make payments to the State Fair of Texas.
All returned or insufficient funds checks will be subject to a \$40.00 fee.
 7. All entry forms must be typed or printed. Incomplete entry forms will be returned.
 - *8. You will be notified by mail as to the status of your entry after judging. Those entries not receiving a ribbon must be picked up on Thursday, September 13, Friday, September 14, or Saturday, September 15, 2007. Hours will be 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Thursday and Friday and 8:30 am to 12:00 noon on Saturday. Those entries receiving a ribbon will be displayed during the fair and must be picked up after the fair on Thursday, October 25, Friday, October 26, or Saturday, October 27, 2007. Hours will be 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Thursday and Friday and 8:30 am to 12:00 noon on Saturday.
 - *9. Only the food contests that are cooked in the building require registration to reserve an oven. Participants are limited to the first sixteen to register. Use the food contest entry form. No phone reservations accepted.
 - *10. Entry fees will not be refunded or transferred, however, a class number may be changed within a department at the time the entry is brought in to us. Two or more entries may never be made in the same class number. Only one entry is allowed in a class number.
 11. The General Rules, department rules and contest rules as published in this handbook will govern all entries and should be read by each participant.
