Articles in the Designer-Craftsman Department must be completely finished and must have been completed within the last year. Each stained glass hanging piece and any other hanging item must be sturdily equipped with proper hangers, chains and screws. Each exhibitor is permitted to enter only 2 classes. No item larger than 36" x 36" will be accepted in this department. No item weighing more than 25 pounds will be accepted in this department.

Teachers and Professionals may not enter the Adult Section

Awards will be made on quality of workmanship and originality of design. **ALL ENTRIES IN THE DESIGNER-CRAFTSMAN DEPARTMENT MUST BE ORIGINAL WORK; NO RIBBON WILL BE AWARDED TO ARTICLES MADE FROM KITS.**

A "Best-of-Show" Ribbon will be awarded in the Adult Section, Teacher & Professional Section, Junior Section and Children's Section.
