Due to limited display area each entrant is encouraged to build as small as is practical for the subject. No sizes larger than 36" long x 36" high x 18" deep. No item weighing more than 35 lbs. will be accepted in this Dept.

Edible food substance will not be accepted on items entered.

KIT

The model that has been built from components of a single commercial kit substantially as the manufacturer of the kit intended. Color schemes and/or markings may be changed; minor structural changes and nominal addition of non-kit components may be made to correct and/or improve detailing.

Judging will be on the basis of complexity of original kit, accuracy of representation, overall workmanship and total impression of the model.

ADULT KIT CONVERSION

The model must demonstrate the use of components of commercial kits combined with hand-built parts and/or significant structural changes to kit components. "Super-detailed stock" kits will be accepted in this section. The entrant should submit a statement of the general work involved in the construction of the model.

Judging will be on the basis of difficulty of technique, amount of handwork involved, overall workmanship and total impression of the model.

L107. Any subject

ADULT SCRATCH BUILT

The model must be a scale representation of a full size prototype. Kit components and/or commercial parts may be used only in an incidental manner. The entrant should submit a statement describing the general features of the work involved in the model.

Judging will be on the basis of originality of subject, accuracy of representation, overall workmanship and total impression of the model.

ADULT DIORAMA

Any scene representing the class theme will be accepted. Commercial pre-built components may be used as required. All components must be securely mounted to a single base that does not exceed 12" x 18". No diorama component may be entered in any other class.

DOLL HOUSE

The entry must be a building consisting of more than 1 room and built to a scale no larger than 1 inch = 1 foot. Furnishings, if included, must be appropriate for the building, to the same scale, and **MUST BE SECURED IN PLACE**. The entry must include a significant amount of handwork by the entrant. A description of this handwork should be submitted.

The maximum allowable base size will be 36 inches by 48 inches. The height should not exceed 42 inches. Sturdy transparent protective covering must be furnished if sides are left open to view the interior furnishings.

“Best-of-Show” will be awarded.
